When declaring a package, there is the PACKAGE and PACKAGE BODY (similar to interface in Java)

The package body is the defined functions and procedures and are public by default

Procedures declared in the body that are not declared in the package are not public

```
package  
  function ABC() return number;  
  procedure DEF();  
package body  
  function ABC() return number;  
  end ABC()  
  procedure DEF();  
  end DEF()
```

Comments in PL/SQL are --

Each function, procedure, and packages must have END
