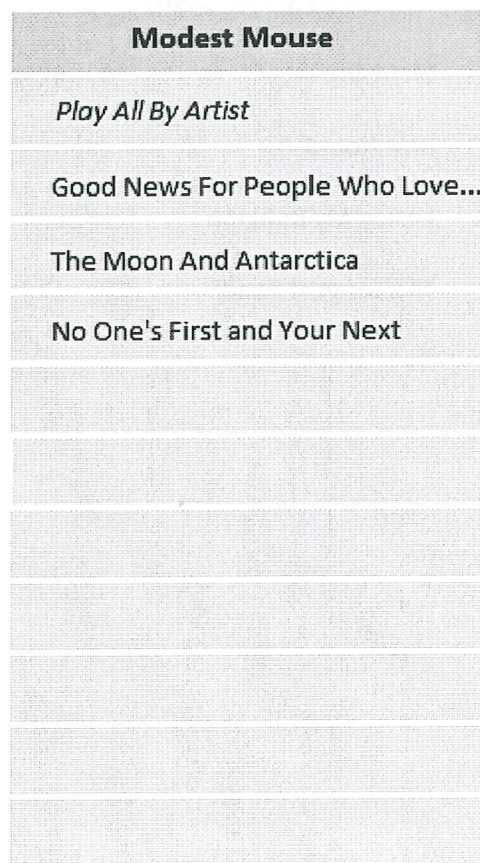

This selection allows a user to play all songs by a particular artist. During the Contextual Interview, the user was asked if there was an ability to play all songs by a particular artist and the answer was no. The following screen is shown when the user selects an artist. It includes the artist's name as the header, the option to play all songs by this artist, as well as each album from the artist below.

Add To Playlist

The ability to make changes to a playlist was a feature mentioned during the Contextual Inquiry. For the redesign, on each playlist screen, a plus symbol appears on the top left. When a user presses this button, the full list of songs available are displayed and a user may add a song into the playlist. The newly added song appears at the bottom of the list of songs already included in the playlist. If a user chooses to remove a song, he/she can swipe right to left over a song to delete it from the playlist.

Change Song Information

Because categorization was not useful, the user mentioned during the Contextual Inquiry that it would be useful to change a song's information, usually to correct, so that categorization did a better job. 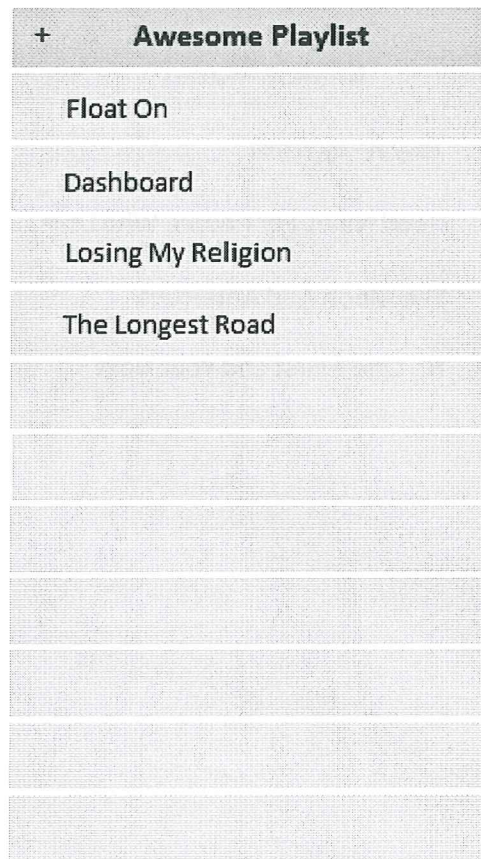
